Quick Instructions

Step 1: Draw Your Place

Sketch a place you know: roads, rivers, landmarks, natural features.

Step 2: Important Places & Uses

Homes, livestock, farming, cultural/community spaces.

Step 3: Past Activities / History

Old dumps, pipelines, abandoned buildings, past land use.

Step 4: Concerns or Risks (use RED)

Mark possible contamination or unsafe areas.

Step 5: Water & Movement (use BLUE)

Show water flow and direction. Where could contamination travel?

Step 6: People, Animals, & What Matters

Who uses the land? What should be protected?

Step 7: Future Vision (use GREEN)

What could this place become?

Final Step:

Circle ONE place where action could begin.

Tips: Use symbols and arrows. Include what you know and what you're unsure about.
