

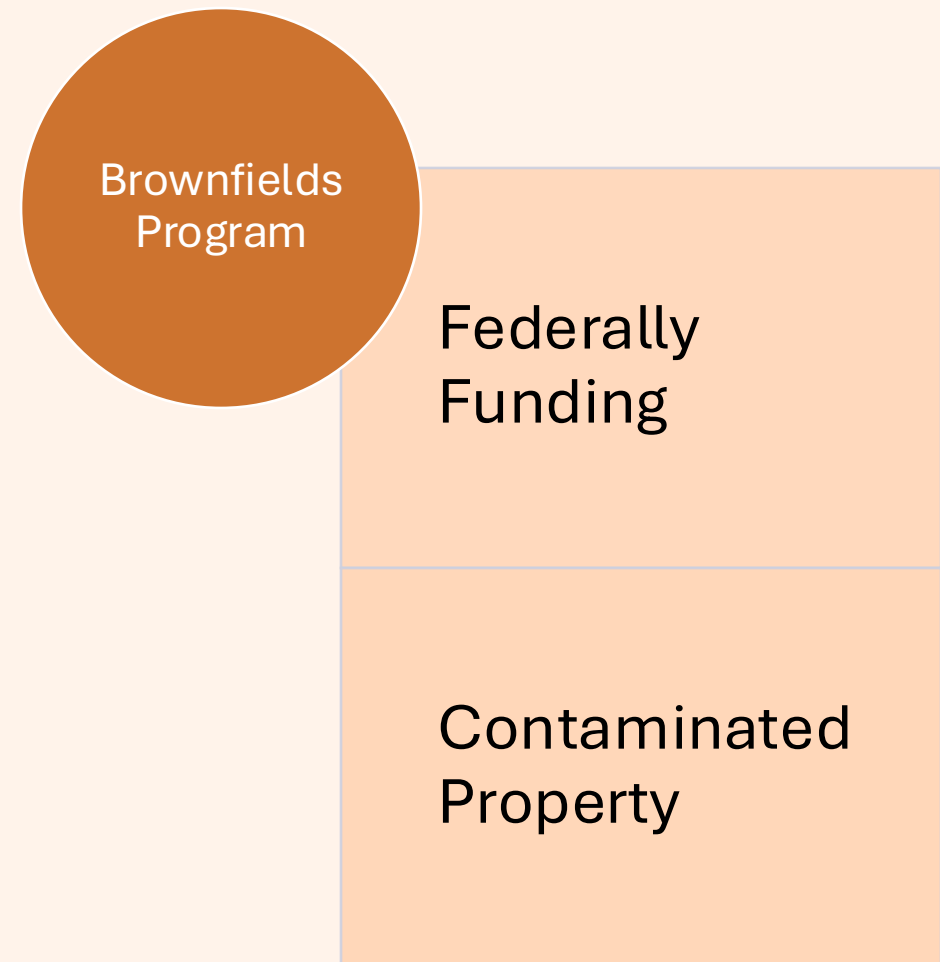

Solid Waste Clean Up Options

RESOURCE CONSERVATION AND RECOVERY PROGRAM

- On Going Uploading Onto IHS National Database of Illegal Trash Dump Sites
- Dump Site “Greater Than or Equal” to 1.0 Acre Qualify for IHS Funding for Clean Up
- Dump Site “Less Than” 1.0 Acres May Use the Indian General Assistance Program (GAP) Funds from USEPA R9
- Dump Site “Less Than” 1.0 Acres May Use Grant Funded Opportunities for Clean Up or Use Voluntary Community Organized Clean Up Sources

Solid Waste Clean Up Options

BROWNFIELDS PROGRAM

- Provides funding, technical assistance, and support to help community assess, clean up, and sustainably reuse contaminated or potentially contaminated properties
- Community-wide Assessment Grants – Funding planning, site inventories, environmental reviews, and development of cleanup and reuse plans
